She was the3, most luxurious ship4 built and the passenger list included aristocrats and millionaires,5 hundreds of poor immigrants heading for a new life in America. Most6 never see it.
9 10 11 12 13 14	Four days out, at 11:40 p.m., she struck an iceberg. The iceberg <u>bumped</u> along the <u>hull</u> for approximately 100 metres, <u>gouging out</u> a hole that was little larger7 the size of a desk. But it was enough8 the ship's "double hull" and the so-called "water-tight compartments", the seawater <u>gushed in</u> . Two and a half hours9 the Titanic had submerged in the freezing waters of the Atlantic and sank for her final resting place. Of the 2 208 passengers and

Of the 2,208 passengers and crew on board, only 650 made it to the lifeboats, another 55 managed to survive in the icy waters until they were rescued. The remaining one and half thousand died. It was a tragedy that soon became a modern myth10 newspapers were full of stories of how the orchestra continued to play, even as the ship was going down. Later we learned that there would never been enough lifeboats for
20 21	everyone and it was the first-class passengers who were given priority. We also heard how the first lifeboat was almost empty; it was occupied only by the
