### TEXT COMPLERT.-

- 1 1 British author J.K. Rowling captured the imagination of children and adults alike  
2 with **her** best-selling series of books about Harry Potter, a  
3 young sorcerer in training. The books **were** acclaimed by both  
4 critics and readers and generated a new interest in reading among children, the  
5 books' intended audience.
- 6 2 Joanne Kathleen Rowling **was born** on July 31, 1965, in Chipping  
7 Sodbury, near Bristol, England. She grew up in Chepstow, Gwent, Wales, where  
8 she **wrote** her first story at the age of 6. After graduating from  
9 the University of Exeter in 1986, Rowling **began working** for  
10 Amnesty International in London. The idea for the Harry Potter stories came to  
11 her during a train trip in 1990, and she **began** writing the magic adventure while  
12 sitting in cafés and pubs. In the early 1990s she travelled to Portugal to teach  
13 English as a foreign language, but after a **brief** marriage and the birth of her  
14 daughter, she returned to the United Kingdom, settling in Edinburgh, Scotland.  
15 Living on public assistance between jobs as a French teacher, she continued to  
16 write, often on scraps of paper and napkins.
- 17 3 After **being rejected** by several publishers, Rowling's **first** manuscript  
18 was accepted by Bloomsbury Children's Books in 1996. *Harry Potter and the*  
19 *Philosopher's Stone* (1997) was an immediate success. Offering vivid  
20 descriptions and an imaginative story line, it followed the adventures of the  
21 exceptional hero Harry Potter, a lonely orphan who discovers that he is actually a  
22 wizard who as a baby survived an attack by Lord Voldemort, a sorcerer  
23 **so evil** that **few** will say his name. Upon  
24 learning his true identity, Harry enrolls at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and  
25 Wizardry, where he continues to battle the forces of darkness.
- 26 4 Proposing a seven-volume series—one volume for each of Harry's years at  
27 Hogwarts—Rowling has **so far** published five books. The **fifth**  
28 volume, *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix*, appeared in 2003 and broke  
29 publishing records by selling 5 million copies **on** June 21,  
30 the date of its publication.
