- 7 Sodbury, near Bristol, England. She grew up in Chepstow, Gwent, Wales, where
- 8 she **wrote** her first story at the age of 6. After graduating from
- 9 the University of Exeter in 1986, Rowling began working for
- Amnesty International in London. The idea for the Harry Potter stories came to
- her during a train trip in 1990, and she **began** writing the magic adventure while
- sitting in cafés and pubs. In the early 1990s she travelled to Portugal to teach
- English as a foreign language, but after a *brief* marriage and the birth of her
- daughter, she returned to the United Kingdom, settling in Edinburgh, Scotland.
- Living on public assistance between jobs as a French teacher, she continued to
- write, often on scraps of paper and napkins.

17 3 After being rejected by several publishers, Rowling's *first* manuscript

- was accepted by Bloomsbury Children's Books in 1996. Harry Potter and the
- 19 Philosopher's Stone (1997) was an immediate success. Offering vivid
- descriptions and an imaginative story line, it followed the adventures of the
- exceptional hero Harry Potter, a lonely orphan who discovers that he is actually a
- wizard who as a baby survived an attack by Lord Voldemort, a sorcerer
- so evil that few will say his name. Upon
- learning his true identity, Harry enrolls at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and
- Wizardry, where he continues to battle the forces of darkness.
- 26 4 Proposing a seven-volume series—one volume for each of Harry's years at
- 27 Hogwarts—Rowling has *so far* published five books. The **fifth**
- volume, Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix, appeared in 2003 and broke
- 29 publishing records by selling 5 million copies **on** June 21,
- 30 the date of its publication.
