We can say it is a circus as well as a museum on wheels since the circus carriages<sup>2</sup> are covered with pictures of artists from the 20's and 30's who are definitely part of the circus history. That was the time of the great artists, such as the Colonnas, the first flying trapeze artists, and the rest that followed.
- Nowadays, the circus is like a modern transport company which moves around with souped-up <sup>3</sup>lorries, quickly and comfortably. However, the Raluy circus sticks to the old-style carriages which move from place to place no faster than 40 kmh, because, according to Carles Raluy, people seem to appreciate what they offer; something different from the everyday. Not only ordinary people are attracted to
- 15 the Raluy, but also many artists who do paintings next to the circus whenever they come to the Port Vell in Barcelona. Some of them, such as Pujol Boira, have dedicated their work to them.
